NEW BUSINESS

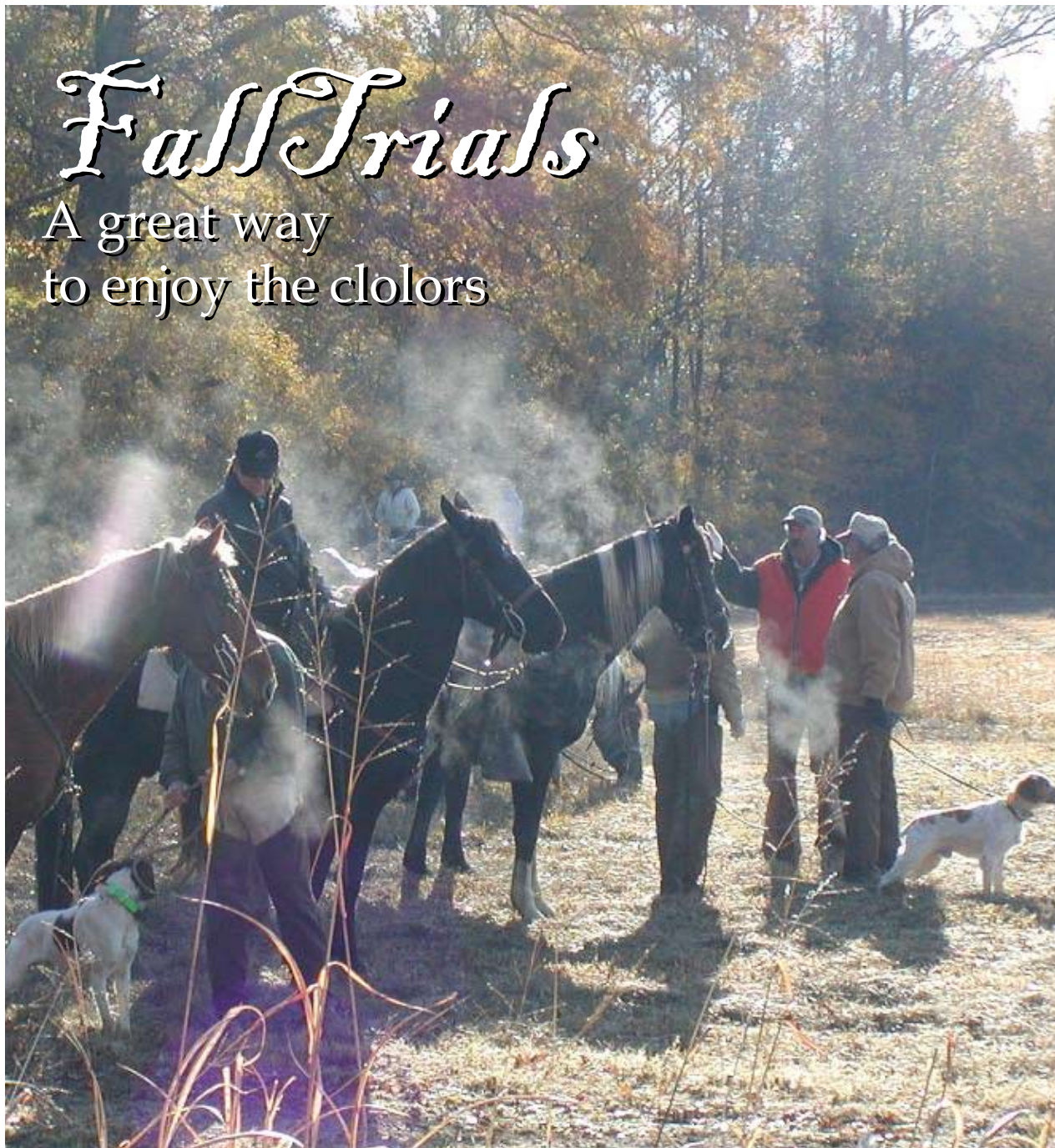
- The SCVBC annual meeting and banquet will occur on January 16th at a site TBD. Please mark your calendars; it is a fun event.
